Sawtry Car Scheme
help?***

Sawtry Car Scheme provides door-to-door transport for people who do not have the use of a car and are unable to use conventional public transport.

Journeys are arranged through the co-ordinator and are provided by volunteers using their own cars. As the scheme relies on a team of volunteers, there cannot be a guarantee that every request for a lift can be fulfilled.

The service is available to people living in Sawtry and the immediate surrounding area who are unable to make vital journeys by any other means.

Passengers pay a contribution of 45p per mile (minimum charge of £2.00) each time they use the service which goes towards the cost of their journey. This must be paid in cash on the day. In addition any necessary car parking fees must also be paid by the passenger.

What is the Christmas Day Party?

How does it work?

Anyone interested in joining us for the day can apply for a place by contacting the CARESCO office from mid-September onwards (limited spaces available). Guests who are willing and able are invited to get involved with the planning and preparations in advance.

On the big day itself, guests arrive from mid-day and are welcomed with drinks and nibbles. Help with transport is available if needed. Following a traditional Christmas Lunch, the afternoon includes entertainment and a sing-a-long and a visit from Santa before people start to leave around 4pm with a gift and piece of Christmas cake to take home.
