Sawtry Car Scheme
help?***

Sawtry Car Scheme provides door-to-door transport for people who do not have the use of a car and are unable to use conventional public transport.

Journeys are arranged through the co-ordinator and are provided by volunteers using their own cars. As the scheme relies on a team of volunteers, there cannot be a guarantee that every request for a lift can be fulfilled.

The service is available to people living in Sawtry and the immediate surrounding area who are unable to make vital journeys by any other means.

Passengers pay a contribution of 45p per mile (minimum charge of £2.00) each time they use the service which goes towards the cost of their journey. This must be paid in cash on the day. In addition any necessary car parking fees must also be paid by the passenger.

What is The Friendship Club?

Our Club members meet for conversation, companionship and to share a two-course meal cooked fresh on the day. Everyone helps with small tasks such as making drinks, laying tables or washing up.

How does it work?

We meet on Mondays and Tuesdays from 10.30am – 1.30pm at The CARESCO Centre in Sawtry. Members living in Sawtry are offered transport to the Centre, while some choose to make their own way. The Sawtry Car Scheme may be able to help those who live outside the village. We can be flexible with attendance and couples are welcome.

Drinks are available throughout the session and there is a freshly prepared two course meal at mid-day.

Members are invited to join in on a number of outings per year when we hire a coach and go out of the village to enjoy lunch together at a local pub or garden centre.

We can accept referrals from individuals, family members, or partner agencies in the local area such as GPs

CARESCO is a Sawtry-based charity, here to serve the local community. There are a range of activities which currently come under the CARESCO umbrella including the Alconbury Thursday Club, the Vintage Club, the Sawtry Car Scheme and the Sawtry Eye magazine. Our purpose-built Centre was opened in 2001, it is fully accessible, including specialised toilets with alarm pulls. The Centre is sited off road with plenty of parking available.

How much does it cost?

There is an attendance fee of £5.00 per session to help cover the running costs of providing the service with an additional charge for transport.
