WHAT IS SOUNDS GOOD?

Our Sounds Good social group meets twice a month to enjoy activities relating to music and / or the spoken word. The group is open to anyone with relevant interests who would like to explore fun and easy activities with others.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Sounds Good meet on the 2nd and 4th Fridays of each month (apart from Good Friday and Christmas) from 1.30pm to 3pm in the CARESCO Centre. We enjoy an hour of activity which could be a themed sing-a-long, trying out a musical instrument, sharing a favourite poem, a visiting guest or even a quiz. Once the activity has finished, we share refreshments together.

Past sessions have included singing songs from wellknown musicals or bands, playing hand bells or homemade instruments, and accompanying guest performers.

The only requirement is a willingness to join in and have fun. There are no auditions, all levels of ability are welcome.

The first session is free, thereafter we ask for a contribution of £2.00 per session to help towards the costs.
