What is Sawtry Food Bank?

The food bank is a partnership between the congregations of the Sawtry churches & CARESCO and works directly with the Godmanchester & Yaxley Foodbanks. Together we provide emergency food for local people going through crisis.

Godmanchester Foodbank is affiliated to the Trussell Trust and has oversight for the Sawtry and Yaxley food banks.

Vouchers can be taken to any of our local food banks.

The volunteers who run them offer tea, coffee, cakes, biscuits and a friendly listening ear. They can also help with completing forms and pointing people towards other agencies who could assist in finding longer term solutions.

A warm welcome awaits and discretion is guaranteed.

How much does it cost?

There is no charge to use the food bank.

The food collection points around the village can be found at the CARESCO Centre, the CARESCO Charity shop, Sawtry Co-Operative Foodstore, Sawtry Methodist Church, All Saints' Church and once a month at St Benedict's Catholic Community who meet in the WI Hall.

How does it work?

The food bank can provide enough food 'basics' for around three days for those in time of crisis. Our packages are designed for emergencies and contain a small range of 'must haves' for those who could not get by without it.

We operate a voucher system. Local community agencies are responsible for providing these to those in genuine need. Anyone in receipt of a voucher is welcome to come along to a session at any of the local Foodbanks to exchange it for a food package.
